Longines FEI World Cup League Declarations

Please be sure to check your World Cup League (East or West) ahead of the first World Cup Competition in which you compete. The [2026/2027 Longines FEI North American League memo](#) contains a summary of key rules, as well as qualification information for the 2027 FEI World Cup Jumping Finals in Gothenburg, SWE from March 24-28, 2027, and preliminary logistics information.

Key Notes:

- Athletes wishing to update their declared sub league must do so prior to competing in their first World Cup competition for the 2026/2027 season. See memo for details.
- An athlete's best 4 results (out of 7 events) will count for qualification for the Final. Full points may be earned in all North American League Events.
- The following athletes will qualify from the North American League: Top Seven (7) U.S. athletes from the East Coast and Top Three (3) U.S. athletes from the West Coast.
