Shayna grew up in Northern California riding Peruvian Pasos with her grandfather and mother on their ranch in Fair Oaks. As a third-generation rider, horses have always been a huge part of her life, and her passion for dressage started as young as age 6.

She has had the honor of riding and training with some of the best trainers in the world including Willy Arts, Steffen Wolfe, Anabelle and Klaus Balkenhol, Guenter Seidel, Steffen and Shannon Peters, Scott Hassler and Allison Brock. For 5 years, Shayna trained at Arroyo Del Mar, home of Steffen and Shannon Peters, where she successfully competed in the Grand Prix, competed in an international CDI Small Tour, was ranked in the top 10 in the country, and ultimately received her USDF Gold medal.

Shayna is a USEF Para-Dressage Master Level Coach and served at the 2020 Tokyo Paralympics for athlete Beatrice de Lavalette. She coaches dressage and para-dressage riders out of her homebase in Loxahatchee, FL.
